Debugging Steps

- 1. Read the error message
- 2. Clarify the problem
- 3. Figure out the logic behind the code
- 4. Review the code line by line
- 5. Test on a small sample
- 6. Simplify the code
- 7. Google the error message of problem
- 8. Ask the experts

Read the error message Discard your fear. Don't take it personal. It probably tells you what went wrong and where.

Clarify the problem What should have happened? What happened?




Figure out the logic behind the code What is the bigger picture? How does the structure look like? Cause and effect: What leads/contributes to what? \rightarrow Read the manual for PCIbex or my experiments.



Review the code line by line Check for for obvious typos:

- wrong variable/file/column name
- missing parenthesis
- missing quotation marks
- misplaced semicolon
- misplaced colon



Test on a small sample 20 items, 40 fillers, 4 lists Leave the whole experiment for the last test(s).

- 1 item sentences, 0 fillers
- 2 item sentences, 2 fillers, 1 list
- 2 item sentences, 2 fillers, 2 lists

... and expand from there.



Simplify the code

Test the elements separately until they work. Copy the code for **only one element**. Make **minimal changes** incrementally

→ Read their documentation for PCIbex or my experiments.


Google error message or general problem

"pcibex comprehension questions"

And click through the first 3-5 hits that seem to apply.

 \rightarrow Read their documentation:

- Frequently Asked Questions,
- PCIbex documentation,
- PCIbex support forum,
- my experiments documentation.



Ask the experts Don't "ask to ask", just ask. Provide a Minimal Reproducible Example Who to ask: me, PCIbex support forum, ...
